Please share your other suggestions for sources and specific repertoire. I know I am currently enjoying discovering the works of contemporary composer Adolphus Hailstork. I was introduced to his works for flute through Laurel Zucker's CD Lil' Lite O' Mine: Flute Music By Composers of African Descent, recorded by Laurel Zucker on the flute and John Cozza on piano.

Also, hopefully within this program year, GPFS will be collaborating with <u>Dr. Nadine Luke</u>, who is with the Flute & Music History program at Bringham Young University–Idaho Department of Music, to bring her research on <u>intermediate level flute music</u> from under-represented composers to our GPFS members. She is also currently working on a publicly available webpage to make this knowledge broadly accessible. We will be sharing that as it comes to fruition as well.

"To discover music by underrepresented composers, some useful resources include <u>The Boulanger Initiative</u>, <u>The New Muses Project</u>, and <u>The Composers Equity Project</u>, which is published by Chamber Music America. The League of American Orchestras also posts a collection of <u>Databases</u> of Repertoire by Underrepresented Composers.

Many portals to find scores are listed on the <u>Practice Page</u> at <u>MusiciansWay.com</u>."

this topic, it covers content such as: music history; theory; practice; collaboration; hardware for
